Recommendations for Course Selection

- Add all courses you take to your schedule in LSF (→ in LSF course catalogue select course and press "Add to schedule").
- Send an email with your full name, your matriculation number <u>and</u> a list of all exams you have taken at the Economics Department or the Munich School of Management to the Economics Examination Office <u>isc@econ.lmu.de</u>.
- If you have taken any courses from departments other than Economics or Management, please ask the respective lecturer to upload your examination results directly in LSF.


