- **Bachelor level:** Some elective modules are taught in English
- **Master level:** Entire program is taught in English

\* Please note that generally exchange students cannot participate in seminars (= 12 ECTS courses) offered by the Department of Economics

  - Do not overstrain yourself!



- 3) If you have taken any courses from departments other than Economics or Management, please ask the respective lecturer to upload your examination results directly in LSF.
