EXCHANGE IN EUROPE



<u>Erasmus+ is the European Union's program</u> for education, youth and sport. The program promotes academic mobility for students (study abroad and internships abroad).



Erasmus+/Swiss Mobility

- Exchange agreements with partner universities in Europe
- Exemption from paying university fees at the host university



UK

- Still partner, but not part of Erasmus+
- For stays longer than 6 months, a visa is required (attention: costs, language certificates, ...)
- Carefully check accepted language certificates at host university



Mobility Grant

- Erasmus+: Erasmus scholarship from the International Office, amount depends on the destination country (approx. 150 300 € per month)
- Swiss Mobility: Application for financial support at the host university







OVERVIEW



Application period for the academic year 2024/25: November 15, 2023 – January 15, 2024 (3 p.m.)

- Application always one year in advance
- Only one application period per year (for winter and summer term)

Specify up to 6 priorities in the application process

Specify and upload all required information and documents

Only necessary if European universities are among your priorities

TAKING THE DECISION OF YOUR PRIORITIES



Plan your semester abroad

Find out about the course offerings, lecture times, etc. on the relevant websites:

- Website Economics Exchange Program
- Website Partner Universities (Admission requirements, course offerings, lecture periods)
- Website MoveOn (Experience reports)

Prioritize your 6 preferred host universities

- Choose based on your true preferences: the chances of getting a place at your Prio-1 university cannot be increased by choosing strategically nor by specifying fewer priorities
- Only consideration in the succession procedure if you have specified six preferences

Please inform yourself independently and in good time.

Online Tool of the Economics Exchange Office

The application for students of economics (Erasmus+ & Economics Partners worldwide) is running on our online tool, which separates applicants based on their degree program (bachelor/master). The online application tool is activated at the start of the application period, and is inaccessible before that.

Upload of required documents

- Current transcript of records (LSF-Kontoauszug)
- Motivational letter for your first priority (English)
- CV (English)
- Bachelor's certificate
- Proof of proficiency for all languages required by your priorities*
- * Please carefully read through the International Office's rules and regulations regarding proof of language proficiency (German).



Proof of Language Proficiency

- German High school diploma (CERF must be explicitly indicated)
- Language courses in the transcript ("Zusatzleistungen")
- Language tests (TOEFL iBT, IELTS, Cambridge Certificate, DELF/DALF, AbiBac und DELE)
- LMU language certificate: Language Center of LMU

As soon as one of your priority universities is part of the European/Erasmus/Swiss University selection you also have to register and apply via the Erasmus online tool of the International Office of LMU.

APPLICATION



Good & successful Application

- Specifying multiple universities (order of preference)
- Sufficient language skills
- Study progress according to study plan
- Good motivational letter



Apply completely and on time

- Carefully read the information on the website
- If you are unsure, please attend the consultation hours in good time (note: holiday season at the turn of the year)
- Only complete applications will be considered
- Do not apply last minute; after the deadlines have expired, applications are no longer possible without exception

5. Next Steps

PLACEMENT PROCEDURE



The multi-stage placement procedure runs through the Economics Exchange Office and starts immediately after the application deadline. You will receive further information by email after the application deadline (January 15th).

Information about the status of your application at each stage

"Offer"

- Active acceptance of the place within the phase is necessary
- Otherwise, exclusion from the placement procedure

"Offer, destination to be determined"

- Guaranteed spot
- Higher priority may be available

"No offer in the current phase"

- No guarantee of spot
- Spot may still be available

"No offer"

Rejection

Succession Procedure

- Open spots within the Economics Exchange Program will be allocated in the succession procedure
- Participation only possible if you did not receive a spot at one of your 6 priorities
- After the regular placement procedure, information about the succession procedure will be sent via email (no additional application necessary)





5. Next Steps AFTER ACCEPTANCE OF EXCHANGE SPOT



After the placement and succession procedures have been completed, you will receive further information about the next steps by email.

Next Steps

- Nomination at host university
- Application/enrollment at the host university
- Course selection and pre-approval of study credits
- Preparation of Erasmus documents
- (Online) Learning Agreement
- If necessary, vacation semester
- Application for credit transfer after return
