Accommodation Information

School of Economics at Zhejiang University will assign on-campus dormitories for exchange students. The payment is amid 40-70 RMB per day. In case there are no available rooms in the campus, they will provide assistance with finding suitable housing. And each exchange student will receive a student ID card, which functions as meal card and with which the student can access to all kinds of facilities on campus. The living expense is about 1000 RMB per month (not including accommodation), depending on life styles.
